



Scott Woods, *incumbent*

Scott Woods is the president/CEO of South Carolina Federal Credit Union in North Charleston, S.C., a position he has held for the past 18 years. Previously, Mr. Woods acted as chief financial officer for South Carolina Federal Credit Union, as well as for SRP Federal Credit Union and SC Telco Federal Credit Union (now known as Spero Financial).

Mr. Woods currently serves as vice chairman of Vizo Financial's board of directors and was a member and past chairman of First Carolina Corporate Credit Union's board prior to the merger. He currently serves on the board of PaymentsFirst and the Governmental Affairs Committee of the Carolinas Credit Union League. His previous board service and leadership includes the boards of the Credit Union National Association (CUNA), South Carolina Credit Union League and Palmetto Cooperative Services, LLC. In addition, he has served on the CUNA Governmental Affairs Committee and the Community Investment Council of the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond.

In the community, he has served on the boards of Charleston Southern University, the Charleston Metro Chamber of Commerce and the Lowcountry Red Cross.

Mr. Woods holds several degrees and certifications. He received his bachelor's degree in accounting from the College of Charleston and his MBA with a specialization in finance from Auburn University. He is a graduate of the Southeast Regional Credit Union Management School and the CUNA Financial Management School. In addition, he is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA), a Certified Internal Auditor and a Chartered Global Management Accountant.

Mr. Woods feels that his years as a chairman during the financial crisis and past experience at credit unions of all sizes qualifies him for re-election to Vizo Financial's board of directors.
