Ukrainian Relief Efforts

Through Vizo Financial’s relationship with their local communities and Ukrainian Selfreliance FCU, and in response to the war in Ukraine, Vizo Financial conducted a donation drive at all four of their campuses for needed items for Ukrainians. The Corporate also supported the Ukrainian Credit Union Displacement Fund, which is managed by the Worldwide Foundation for Credit Unions. Vizo Financial raised \$37,525 and matched the raised contributions with a \$25,000 donation. A total of \$62,525 was donated to the Fund.

“Our staff spent many hours volunteering, contributing and supporting our communities in 2022,” said Erin Doan, Vizo Financial’s diversity, equity and inclusion director. “From supporting our usual organizations like Victory Junction and CMN Hospitals to supporting more local organizations in their communities, our staff went above and beyond this year.”
