**Female voice:** Let's take a look at what some credit unions are doing in their local communities!

**Female voice:** Over in Dover, Del., Del-One FCU had more than 170 employees .

**Female voice:** Summit CU in Greensboro, N.C., held their second annual Charity Car Show in October and raised over \$2,100 for Backpack Beginnings. They also received donations in the form of canned goods and supplies for the organization as well.

**Female voice:** In York, Pa., First Capital FCU collected school supplies which were then distributed to local schools in the district.

**Female voice:** Mercer County Community FCU in Hermitage, Pa., joined forces with two non-profits in their community to offer financial literacy services to community members. They're also volunteering with Clearview FCU to teach financial literacy skills at Junior Achievement's BizTown.

**Female voice:** In Danville, Pa., Service 1st FCU held its 28th Annual Charity Golf Tournament and raised a total of \$54,000 for two organizations - Good Samaritan Mission and ThinkBIG.

**Female voice:** TruMark Financial CU in Fort Washington, Pa., donated 60 backpacks filled with school supplies to local non-profits for children in need.

**Female voice:** In Waynesboro, Va., DuPont Community CU donated \$20,000 from its Shop & Give campaign to the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank, which in turn provided 80,000 meals to families.

**Female voice:** SRP FCU in North Augusta, S.C., recently reached the milestone of donating over one million dollars to local high schools since 2018 through its Affinity School Debit Card Program.

**Female voice:** Down in Greenville, S.C., Spero Financial CU, contributed over \$120,000 to a local hospital to fund the AnMed Mobile Mammography bus, which provides women easy access to mammogram screenings.

**Female voice:** In response to Hurricane Ian, BayPort CU in Newport News, Va., donated \$10,000 to the Salvation Army in Florida.

**Female voice:** In November, White Rose Credit Union over in York, Pa., collected non-perishable food items for the York County Food Bank.

**Female voice:** People First FCU, in Allentown, Pa., presented \$1,000 scholarships to five high school seniors for its fourth annual Youth Scholarship Awards Program.

**Female voice:** To celebrate a 28-year relationship with UPMC, Belco Community CU, located in Harrisburg, Pa., donated \$2,500 to UPMC Pinnacle Foundation's Philip W. Guarneschelli Legacy Fund.

**Female voice:** Merck Sharp and Dohme FCU in Chalfont, Pa., raised nearly \$10,000 for two local non-profits: Sebastian Riding Associates, an organization that provides equine-assisted therapy programs, and The Shepherd's Shelf, an emergency food pantry.

We also provided a \$5,000 sponsorship to CMN Hospitals Duke Children's Hospital for their annual Radiothon in December and made a financial donation towards the CrossState Credit Union Foundation's WalletPalooza fundraising event that was held this month.
